



Looking Ahead to Fall 2021

Saint Mark Preschool will begin accepting enrollments for the 2021-22 school year in February. If you, or anyone you know, is interested in scheduling a tour of the preschool please contact Chris Stodola at 455-5320.

We are uncertain about what our capacity will be in the fall. If we are requested to maintain current class sizes our openings will again be limited. It will be important to tour and register early to be assured of a place in your preferred class.

We will conduct adult only tours when students are not present. Please make an appointment and plan to follow all of our Covid-19 safety protocols when touring the facility.

Our protocols for touring:

I confirm that I have not had a cough, shortness of breath or difficulty breathing. I confirm that I have not had two or more of the following symptoms: **Fever, Chills, Sore throat, Headache, Fatigue, New loss of taste or smell in the last 3 days.**

I confirm that I have not been in close contact with a person with the above symptoms in the last 3 days.

I have not been in close contact with a person diagnosed with Covid-19 in the past 14 days.

MASKS ARE REQUIRED TO ENTER THE BUILDING

Class options this fall include: a three year old Tuesday/Thursday morning class, a four year old Monday/Wednesday/Friday morning class and, if numbers allow, a four year old afternoon class. We will also offer an extended day option for our morning fours. The number of spaces available for the extended day is limited and students may only add the extended day option at the start of the school year or at mid-year if there are open spaces.

The Bridge Program (older 4's and young 5's) will be a 3 full day program. If your child turns 5 years of age after September 1, 2021, or has a late summer birthday, the Bridge Class is a great way to "bridge" between a preschool program and a 5 full day kindergarten program.

Our tuition rates and fees for the 2021-22 school year will not change. Our payment service, TADS, retains the right to increase their fees for late payments and various payment options. We do not have that information at this time.

There are many preschool opportunities in our community, some are tuition based like Saint Mark, and others are free to qualifying families. Your options are endless. If you would like to attend Saint Mark, but find it difficult financially, we do have a tuition assistance program. Please inquire about the process.
